

Thesis / Central Idea:


The Word of God is not idle and has work to do.

Isaiah 55:11 (NIV)

Introduction:

There is much that could be said about God's Word in both Old and New Testament. Let us focus in on one of its greatest goals that we see fulfilled in our Savior the Christ. Isaiah the Prophet speaks a sure word to the people of God who have not kept His Word and have been destroyed. Judah remains as Isaiah reveals God's ultimate Salvation to be found in Jesus who will later come and deliver us all.

They didn't believe it before and were destroyed, we must believe it now and live. Believe in a way that does not bring destruction but brings everlasting life. Believe where it is more than theory and rhetoric the exercises of mind only. Believe in the way which causes you to act, recognizing the power and authority that His Word has over our lives.

Sermon Outline:

I. God's Word, God's revelation



A. God has always revealed Himself to us and by doing so reveals His will.

John 1:1 (NIV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

- B. God's greatest revelation of himself is His Son Jesus. The Word become flesh.
- C. The Bible calls Jesus the exact representation of His being.

Hebrews 1:3 (NIV)

³ The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

D. If we wanted to know what it is that God is achieving, when can find out in the person of Jesus.

Isaiah 55:11 (NIV)

¹¹ so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

John 5:18–19 (NIV)

¹⁸ For this reason they tried all the more to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God.

¹⁹ Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does.

- E. The Son only speaks that which comes from the Father. If we want to know what God is revealing to us, we need to know the Son.
- F. The revelation that comes from the Son has eternal purpose...

II. God's Word has purpose and eternal endurance

Hebrews 4:12 (NIV)

¹² For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

- A. The work of God's Word may not always be evident, yet it is always at work.
- B. The Word of God will not change to suit the wishes and desires of men.

Matthew 5:18 (NIV)

¹⁸ For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished. John 12:48 (NIV)

⁴⁸ There is a judge for the one who rejects me and does not accept my words; the very words I have spoken will condemn them at the last day.

C. God's Word will endure forever.

Isaiah 55:11 (NIV)

¹¹ so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

1 Peter 1:23-25 (NIV)

²³ For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. ²⁴ For,

"All people are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, ²⁵but the word of the Lord endures forever."

And this is the word that was preached to you.

D. God's Word not only endures but it has power...

III. God's Word has power

A. In the life of Jesus it was noticed very early that His Word had power and authority.

Luke 8:25 (NIV)

²⁵ "Where is your faith?" he asked his disciples.

In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."

B. God's Word has power...

Luke 4:36 (NIV)

³⁶ All the people were amazed and said to each other, "What words these are! With authority and power he gives orders to impure spirits and they come out!"

C. God's Word, His Message, His Revelation to us can be found in His Son Jesus. That message has power to achieve His Will.

1 Corinthians 1:17–18 (NIV)

¹⁷ For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—not with wisdom and eloquence, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

¹⁸ For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

D. That Word/Message is the Gospel of Jesus.

Isaiah 55:11 (NIV)

¹¹ so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

John 5:24 (NIV)

²⁴ "Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life. Romans 1:16 (NIV)

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

E. Believe in the way which causes you to act, recognizing the power and authority that His Word has over our lives...

Isaiah 55:11 (NIV)

¹¹ so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

Conclusion:

God's Word, God's Revelation best seen and understood in His Son King Jesus the Christ.

God's Word has Purpose and Eternal Endurance it will achieve that which He has set it out to do. We need to live in that purpose and be assured that it will endure forever.

God's Word has Power to get the job done. The Word of God will not return void or empty to God, its purpose will be achieved.
