

At the fall

Genesis 3:6 ESV

⁶ So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate.

Among pagans

Romans 1:22-23 ESV

²² Claiming to be wise, they became fools, ²³ and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.

Within Israel the Ekklesia itself

Exodus 20:4-5 ESV

⁴ "You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. ⁵ You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me,

Materialism and possessions

Possessions are to be seen as a gift from God

1 Chronicles 29:12 ESV

¹² Both riches and honor come from you, and you rule over all. In your hand are power and might, and in your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all.

Material goods can turn the heart away from God

1 Timothy 6:9-10 ESV

⁹ But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evils. It is through this craving that some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pangs.

Possessions and riches can make it difficult to enter the kingdom

Matthew 19:23-24 ESV

²³ And Jesus said to his disciples, "Truly, I say to you, only with difficulty will a rich person enter the kingdom of heaven. ²⁴ Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God."

The weaknesses of materialism

It is transitory

Proverbs 27:24 ESV

²⁴ for riches do not last forever; and does a crown endure to all generations?

1 Timothy 6:7 ESV

⁷ for we brought nothing into the world, and we cannot take anything out of the world.

It does not satisfy

Ecclesiastes 5:10 ESV

¹⁰ He who loves money will not be satisfied with money, nor he who loves wealth with his income; this also is vanity.

It can encourage greed

1 Kings 21:2-4 ESV

² And after this Ahab said to Naboth, "Give me your vineyard, that I may have it for a vegetable garden, because it is near my house, and I will give you a better vineyard for it; or, if it seems good to you, I will give you its value in money." ³ But Naboth said to Ahab, "The LORD forbid that I should give you the inheritance of my fathers." ⁴ And Ahab went into his house vexed and sullen because of what Naboth the Jezreelite had said to him, for he had said, "I will not give you the inheritance of my fathers." And he lay down on his bed and turned away his face and would eat no food.

Luke 12:15 ESV

¹⁵ And he said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."
