of music in their worship for hundreds of years after Christ.
The Greek Orthodox Church, which broke off from the Roman Catholic Church, has
never used instrumental music in their worship.
When you attend the worship of the church of Christ, you will notice we do not use
instrumental music in our worship. The following comparisons help to illustrate the reason:
Genesis 6:14 God told Noah, "Make thee an ark of gopher wood."
Would Noah have sinned if he had built the ark of metal or mud?
Would Noah have sinned if he had built the ark of any other wood?
When God said, "Gopher wood," that automatically eliminated
any other ind of wood.
When God said, "Sing," that automatically eliminated any other kind of music.
Leviticus 10:1-2
Did Nadab and Abihu sin when they offered a different kind of fire than God
commanded?
Did God punish them?
Is it important to worship God the way HE has command did without alteration?

Matthew 26:26-29

Would it be a sin to put jam on the bread to improve the taste?

in serving God?
