BEING VERSUS DOING

- When it comes to the Christian faith, there is often a debate between doing and being.
- First, let us clarify what we mean by "doing" and "being."

John 15:5 ESV

⁵ I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.

James 1:22 ESV

²² But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

Romans 8:14-17 ESV

¹⁴ For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. ¹⁵ For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷ and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

SCRIPTURES FOR US (THE SAVED)

RECOGNIZING OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE THE GOSPEL

- 1. Asking questions about faith, God, or spirituality
- 2. Expressing dissatisfaction with their current beliefs or circumstances
- 3. Experiencing a life-changing event or crisis
- 4. Demonstrating curiosity or interest in Christian practices, such as attending church or Bible study

1. BE QUICK TO LISTEN AND SLOW TO SPEAK

¹³ If one gives an answer before he hears, it is his folly and shame.

2. BE ADAPTABLE NOT ONE SIZE FITS ALL

⁵ Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. ⁶ Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.

2 Timothy 4:5 ESV

⁵ As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

2 Corinthians 10:4-5 ESV

⁴ For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds. ⁵ We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ,

Love

Significance

<u>Ps 57:2</u> - knowing the meaning and purpose for your life.

Security

Pro 14:26 - being grounded with an unshakable sense of belonging and acceptance.

1. SALVATION IS A GIFT, NOT THE RESULT OF WORKS

Ephesians 2:8–9 ESV

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

2. THE POWER OF SALVATION IS AVAILABLE

Romans 1:16 ESV

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

3. A MESSAGE FOR ALL THE WORLD ALL ARE INCLUDED

Mark 16:15-16 ESV

And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

4. GOD'S LOVE DEMONSTRATED

1 John 4:9-10 ESV

In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
