

Family Tree: Jesus (Mt 1:1–17)




Gabriel appears to Zechariah in the temple.

Caesar Augustus decrees a census.



Jesus is circumcised.

Angels appear to shepherds.

Simon and Anna prophesy about Jesus. The Magi come to Bethlehem.

Herod kills all male children in Bethlehem.











The Magi ask Herod in Jerusalem about the "King of the Jews."

Joseph, Mary, and Jesus flee to Egypt.

An angel appears to Joseph in Egypt.

- When and how did Mary become pregnant? (18)
- Before she and Joseph came together
- From the Holy Spirit (cf. Lk 1:26-35)

She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

- ➡ What two names would be given the child, and what do they mean? (21-23)
- Jesus (savior); Immanuel (God with us)


- ➡ What scripture in the OT was fulfilled by the virgin birth of Christ? (22-23)
- That written by Isaiah in Isa 7:14

MATTHEW 1:25



- ◆ How long did Joseph wait until he knew Mary as his wife? (25)
- Until she had given birth to her son (Jesus)
