Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church. Eph 1:22-23; Col 1:18


22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church,

23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all.




18 And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.




13 And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.




3. It is the "faith once for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 3).


5. We dare not go beyond what is written (2 John 9-11)!




A CHURCH EXIST IN ONE OF FOUR POSSIBLE STATES.

1. A church may be Scripturally unorganized.


